S.R.O. 19 - In exercise of the powers conferred by the clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 123 of the Coast Guard Act, 1978(30 of 1978) and in supersession of Coast Guard Enrolled Follower Recruitment Rules, 1981, except as respects things are done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Enrolled Follower, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement** - (1) These rules may be called the Coast Guard Enrolled Follower Recruitment Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay/pay scale** - Number of the post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualification and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. **Disqualifications** - No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax** - Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving** .- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

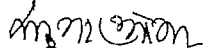

SRO 34. In exercise of the powers conferred by the clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 123 of the Coast Guard Act 1978 and the Ministry of Defence letter No 11(15)/2001/US(Pers)/D(Navy-II) dated 17th August 2001 and in supersession of (i) the Coast Guard Naviks (Technical Branch), Recruitment rules, 1982; (ii) the Coast Guard Naviks (General Duty), Recruitment rules, 1982 and (iii) the Coast Guard Naviks (Domestic Branch), Recruitment rules, 1982, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Pradhan Yantrik, Uttam Yantrik, Yantrik, Pradhan Navik (General Duty), Uttam Navik (General Duty), Navik (General Duty), Pradhan Navik (Domestic Branch), Uttam Navik (Domestic Branch) and Navik (Domestic Branch) in the Coast Guard Organisation under the Ministry of Defence namely :-

1. **Short title and Commencement.-**

(1) These rules may be called as the Coast Guard Yantrik, Navik (General Duty) and Navik (Domestic Branch) (Group 'C/D' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.-**

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in the column (1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.-**

The number of the said posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in column (5) to (14) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Disqualification -** No person, -

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving. -** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Caste, Ex-servicemen, Sportspersons and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

S.R.O. 235 In exercise of the powers conferred by the clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 123 of the Coast Guard Act, 1978 (30 of 1978), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Subordinate Officers (Technical Branch), namely :-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Coast Guard Subordinate Officers (Technical Branch), Recruitment Rules, 1982.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of posts, classification and the scale of pay. Number of posts, classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed thereto.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc. - The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the Schedule aforesaid.
4. Disqualification. - No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any or all of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
