LAUNCH OF "ATAL" – FIFTH FAST PATROL VESSEL FOR INDIAN COAST GUARD BY GOA SHIPYARD LTD

New Delhi, 29 Jul 25: Goa Shipyard Ltd (GSL), a premier Indian DPSU Shipyard, is constructing eight Fast Patrol Vessels for the Indian Coast Guard (ICG). The 5th vessel of the series was launched today in a ceremonious way by Smt Shilpa Agarwal in the presence of Shri Rozy Agarwal, IDAS, PIFA, Coast Guard Headquarters as Chief Guest to the chants of 'Atharva Veda'.
